We are excited to announce a historic moment. The Pastel Society of New Hampshire has teamed up with the Vermont Pastel Society for the first ever twin state member show. Some of you may have artwork completed, others may be in the middle of a pastel painting they would like to submit or in the beginning stages, which is all good. We only need the title(s) and the size(s) by Saturday, December 7th so that we may determine how many members want to display artwork. Once we have a total number of members who want to show their work in combination with the sizes, we will determine if we can fit both your first choice and your second choice painting.

If we have a large turnout with also large paintings, we may only allow one of your paintings in the show due to space constrictions.

Sunday, March 29, 2020 Last day of show

Monday, March 30th: Artwork picked up from hospital gallery

Eligibility:

All PSNH members (current 2019 and any new members 2020) are eligible to enter two pieces, labeled 1st and 2nd choice

Artwork must be framed, labeled and ready to hang appropriately with wire (No sawtooth hooks allowed) **Judge:** Mary is a professional artist whose paintings are luminous and filled with light. Iselin is represented by 3 Pears Gallery in Dorset VT; The Mill Brook Gallery in Concord, NH; Vermont Artisans in Brattelboro, VT; Creative Encounters in Keene, NH; and Sunapee Landing Art Gallery in Sunapee, NH. Commission: The gallery collects a 25% commission from all sold works. Members are allowed to submit NFS work, but you are highly encouraged to have your work for sale. The money collected from the sales supports the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Arts Program.

Medium: Soft Pastel

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to **BOTH** societies. The winners will be announced at the reception on Thursday evening, January 16th, 2020, between 5:00-6::30 pm. The People's choice award will be announced at the culmination of the show. **Prize categories:** Luminous Landscape, Reflective Waterscape, Lively Still Life, Figuratively Speaking, Abstractly Appealing, Totally Tonal, Colorfully Crafted, Shapely and Edgy, Touchingly Textural, Judge's Choice, and People's Choice.

Liability: The Pastel Society of New Hampshire, Pastel Society of Vermont, Dartmouth-Hitchock Hospital, and Lisa Regopoulos, are not responsible for damage or theft in transition to the show or while hanging in the venue. All risk for damage to or loss of artwork at the exhibit as well as transportation to or from the venue is the responsibility of the artist.

How to enter: You may enter up to two paintings.

- Please list your name followed by the title, price and framed dimensions of your paintings with V=Vertical and H=Horizontal (See example)
- Please identify your work the following way: 1. (My First Choice) Lisa Regopoulos-Stormy Day-\$1000.00-23V x 16H, 2. (My Second Choice, if there is room) Lisa Regopoulos-Blue Barn-\$1000.00 23V x16H
- Send above information to Lisa Regopoulos at lregopoulosfineart@gmail.com by Saturday, December 7th the latest. If you do not receive email confirmation within 48 hours, contact Lisa at 978-400-1151.
- As soon as we know how many paintings we can hang, we will let you know which ones to drop off.
- Lisa Regopoulos can take up to 20 paintings (or more depending on sizes) with her for drop off and will receive them at her house: 120 Rinnock Road, Fitchburg, MA 0140, on Sunday, January 5th from 12:00 to 4:00.
